

# ORDINANCE No. 184969

Authorize a contract and provide payment for construction of the Ankeny Pump Station Upgrade Project No. E07833 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has a need to upgrade the existing Ankeny Pump Station.
2. The upgrade of the Ankeny Pump Station is required to increase the long term reliability for this critical pump station, to bring the station into compliance with current BES standards, and to integrate the Ankeny PS into the Westside CSO Control System.
3. The estimated construction cost is \$7,225,000. The level of confidence in this estimate is optimal. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2011/2012, 2012/2013 and 2013/2014 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E07833.C14.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and Auditor are authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.



