

ORDINANCE No. 184975

Accept a grant in the amount of \$98,000 from Oregon Department of Transportation to develop and implement specific efforts to improve transportation safety on six high crash corridors, and to work with the Metro Traffic Safety Workgroup to support transportation safety efforts in the Portland metropolitan area. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland Bureau of Transportation applied to Oregon Department of Transportation for a Safe Community Grant in the amount of \$98,000 to develop and implement specific efforts to improve transportation safety on the high crash corridors of SW Beaverton-Hillsdale Highway, SE Division Street, N/NE Marine Drive, SE Foster Road, 122nd Avenue, and SW Barbur Boulevard, and to work with the Metro Traffic Safety Workgroup to support transportation safety efforts in the Portland metropolitan area on September 8, 2011; and
2. Oregon Department of Transportation has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the development and implementation of specific efforts to improve transportation safety on the high crash corridors of SW Beaverton-Hillsdale Highway, SE Division Street, N/NE Marine Drive, SE Foster Road, 122nd Avenue, and SW Barbur Boulevard, and to work with the Metro Traffic Safety Workgroup to support transportation safety efforts in the Portland metropolitan area to Bureau of Transportation in the amount of \$98,000 effective October 1, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the development and implementation of specific efforts to improve transportation safety on the high crash corridors of SW Beaverton-Hillsdale Highway, SE Division Street, N/NE Marine Drive, SE Foster Road, 122nd Avenue, and SW Barbur Boulevard, and to work with the Metro Traffic Safety Workgroup to support transportation safety efforts in the Portland metropolitan area in the amount of \$98,000.
- b. The FY 2011/2012 budget is hereby amended as follows

- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.


