ORDINANCE No. 184996

Designate two parcels of City property owned in fee title located at SE 99th Ave and SE 100th Ave as public right-of-way for road purposes and assign them to the Bureau of Transportation (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Office of Management and Finance (OMF) controls property owned in fee title by the City of Portland. The property located at 3732 SE 99th Avenue, also referenced as 1S2E09DA Tax Lot 5000, is the current location of the City's Emergency Communications Center.
- 2. The property was acquired from the State of Oregon, Department of Transportation in Book 2143, Page 1674, recorded on September 30, 1988, Multnomah County Deed Records.
- 3. Portland Water Bureau (PWB) controls three properties owned in fee title by the City. The properties are located at 3741 SE 100th Avenue, and 3732 and 3744 SE 99th Avenues. The properties were acquired from a private property owners in Document No. 2008-161272, recorded on November 26, 2008, Document No. 2008-162069, recorded on November 28, 2008, and in Document No. 2009-083190, recorded on June 12, 2009, Multnomah County Deed Records. These properties are also referenced as 1S2E09DA Tax Lots 6400, 6600, and 6700 respectively.
- 4. The three properties controlled by PWB were acquired in order to consolidate land for the development of the City's new Emergency Coordination Center (ECC).
- 5. OMF has submitted an application (No. 11-152159) for a building permit to construct the ECC and as a condition of the permit; a portion of these properties are needed for sidewalk improvements along both SE 99th and SE 100th Avenues.
- 6. The parcels should now be designated as public right-of-way for road purposes and assigned to the Bureau of Transportation.
- 7. There are minimal costs for staff time associated in processing this Designate and Assign, likely not exceeding \$1,000.00. Funds are available in the Emergency Coordination Center Right-of-Way Fund FY 2011/12 Budget, SAP No. 7TRWA0000495.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the following described City-owned properties are hereby designated as public right-of-way for road purposes and assigned to the Bureau of Transportation.

b. That the Auditor shall return a certified copy of the Ordinance to the Right-of-Way Acquisition Section, Bureau of Transportation, for recording in the Multnomah County Deed Records. Right-of-Way Acquisition shall return the original recorded ordinance and retain a copy in R/W File No. 9000-4.
