ORDINANCE No. 185002

* Authorize application to the Oregon Department of Education for a grant in the amount of \$15,000 to implement child wellness practices in afterschool programs (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) sponsors an Afterschool At-Risk Meal Program, which provides nutritious meals to children enrolled in enrichment programs at University Park and St. Johns community centers.
- 2. The Oregon Department of Education is seeking to increase fruit and vegetable consumption, healthy beverage consumption, and physical activity in child care settings by offering grants to support implementation of healthy practices.
- 3. As a sponsor of an Afterschool At-Risk Meal Program, PP&R is eligible to apply for this grant funding.
- 4. Grant funding would be used to develop and implement curriculum related to nutrition, cooking, gardening, and active play at St. Johns and University Park community centers, as well as for education and outreach activities to other PP&R sites, childcare providers, and the community.
- 5. Receiving such funding would significantly advance PP&R's efforts to encourage healthy, active recreation in Portland.
- 6. No match is required by this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Oregon Department of Education for a grant in the amount of \$15,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to meet the application deadline; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
