This Contract was made and entered by and between EPI-USE America, Inc, hereinafter called Contractor, and the City of Portland, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, by and through its duly authorized representatives, hereinafter called City. This Amendment may refer to the City and Contractor individually as a Party or collectively as the Parties.

1. Additional compensation not-to-exceed \$500,000 is necessary due to additional work required beyond what was anticipated at the time contract was executed.

2. This Amendment No. 3 to Contract No. 30000719 increases the total not-to-exceed amount of the contract from \$875,000 to \$1,375,000.

All other terms and conditions shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

\*Amend contract with EPI-USE America, Inc. in the amount of \$500,000 to provide additional SAP ERP System Post Implementation Support, HCM option services. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30000719)

The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On June 25, 2009 a contract was entered into between the City of Portland (City) and EPI-USE America, Inc. to provide SAP ERP SYSTEM POST IMPLEMENTATION SUPPORT, HCM OPTION services.
- 2. The original Contract amount was \$\$700,000 with an expiration date of June 30, 2012.
- 3. Additional SAP ERP SYSTEM POST IMPLEMENTATION SUPPORT, HCM OPTION services are required. The Enterprise Business Solutions Division (EBS) of OMF recommends that Contract No. 30000719 with EPI-USE America, Inc. be amended to increase the compensation by \$500,000.
- 4. The additional compensation under this Ordinance, along with previously added compensation, comes to \$675,000 which is 96% of the original compensation amount of \$700,000. The new not-to-exceed amount of the Contract is \$1,375,000.
- 5. Sufficient funding resides in OMF Internal Service fund 708000 beginning in FY 2011-2012.
- 6. Previous Amendments: 2

Amendment No.1, dated January 7, 2010 provided for elimination of the annual not to exceed amount.

Amendment No.2, dated October 14, 2010 increased the total contract compensation by \$175,000 for a total not to exceed amount of \$875,000

## NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to amend Contract No. 30000719 with EPI-USE America, Inc. for services in accordance with Amendment No. 3 attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because consultant work under this contract is essential to continue meeting the mission critical business needs of bureaus for SAP change requests, break/fixes, and new functionality. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
