ORDINANCE No. 185090

*Authorize grant application to the Federal Highway Administration up to \$1,350,000 for I-405 Couch/Burnside interchange improvements. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. The Federal Highway Administrator has been delegated authority to award Federal financial assistance for a transportation project under the Transportation, Community, and System Preservation Program;
- 2. The grant for Federal financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the City, and may require the City to provide the local share of the project cost;
- 3. The City has or will provide all annual certifications and assurances to the Federal Highway Administration required for the project;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Federal Highway Administration for a grant in the amount up to \$1,350,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to secure the Federal Transit Administration grant for the purpose of completing the conceptual engineering design for Union Station multi-modal transportation facility enhancement; and therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
