Authorize the City Attorney to intervene on behalf of the City of Portland in Oregon Public Utility Commission docket UM 1565. (Resolution).

WHEREAS, the Oregon Public Utilities Commission, ("OPUC"), has opened a docket titled, "Investigation into Fuel Switching and Cross Fuel Efficiency Issues, UM 1565"; and

WHEREAS, this docket will investigate energy efficiency questions related to choosing electricity or natural gas fuels; gas/electricity fuel switching; and the influence of Energy Trust of Oregon incentives on choosing one fuel over the other; and

WHEREAS, Portland's 2009 Climate Action Plan establishes short- and long-term goals for carbon reduction which are greatly influenced by the carbon emissions from generating electricity and use of natural gas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Portland has broad authority under its home rule charter to oversee the activities of utilities within its boundaries, including through the establishment of franchises and the issuance of permits, and is also responsible for the orderly management of public rights-of-way within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, participation by the City as a party in this OPUC filing would permit the City to: (1) obtain important information regarding gas and electric fuel efficiency and other matters not otherwise readily available; (2) be informed of other parties' actions and comments in this proceeding; and (3) influence the outcome of the proceeding for the benefit of the city's Climate Action Plan and for the benefit of the citizens of Portland.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Portland, that the City Attorney is hereby authorized and directed to intervene on behalf of the City as a full party in Oregon Public Utility Commission proceeding UM 1565 to present the City's views and protect its interests as necessary.
