ORDINANCE No. 185098

Transfer ownership and maintenance of public sanitary sewer facilities to the Port of Portland (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance No. 163854, passed by City Council on February 6, 1991, authorized Intergovernmental Agreement No. 27207 (the "IGA"), dated July 17, 1991, between the Port of Portland (the "Port") and the City of Portland (the "City") for the transfer of Port-owned sanitary sewer facilities at the Portland International Airport to the City.
- 2. On September 10, 1999, the Port granted to the City a perpetual easement over said sanitary sewer facilities in recorded document 99-172286. Subsequently, the Port transferred ownership and maintenance of said sanitary sewer facilities to the City in recorded document 99-172287, as called for in the IGA.
- 3. The Port realigned portions of the sanitary sewer lines and facilities during construction of the Headquarters Portland 2 Building Project, resulting in some lines being abandoned for future use by the City.
- 4. The City and the Port desire to transfer ownership and maintenance for the realigned and/or abandoned sanitary sewer facilities back to the Port.
- 5. The City is authorized to transfer said facilities and the Port is authorized to accept the transfer of said facilities.
- 6. Exhibit A of this Ordinance contains a copy of Transfer Document 2011-152

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

The Commissioner-in-Charge and the Auditor to execute an agreement with the Port of Portland for the a. orderly transfer of said sanitary sewer facilities, substantially in accordance with the Transfer Document contained in Exhibit A of this Ordinance.


