

ORDINANCE No. 185104

* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County Department of Community Justice for the County to offset personnel costs of \$49,882 to maintain a Lieutenant position in the Police Bureau Training Division (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Multnomah County and the Portland Police Bureau (PPB) wish for police recruits and members of the PPB to better understand the philosophy and operations of the Department of Community Justice (DCJ), enhance coordination of resources, increase mutual assistance efforts, and improve working relationships between staff of the respective organizations.
2. The PPB will maintain a Lieutenant position in the Bureau's Training Division to develop and facilitate training opportunities for sworn and unsworn officers in accordance with the Agreement.
3. The County will provide information and experiential training opportunities for Bureau staff to increase their knowledge of DCJ philosophy and operations in accordance with the Agreement.
4. The County will offset personnel costs associated with maintaining a Lieutenant in the Bureau's Training Division not to exceed \$49,882 through FY 2012-13. This compensation is broken down in the Agreement. The compensation is based on the difference between a top-step Sergeant and a Lieutenant's pay.
5. The Agreement shall be effective from April 1, 2011, to June 30, 2013. The Agreement may be terminated by either party upon thirty days' written notice.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are authorized to enter into an agreement with Multnomah County Department of Community Justice and the City of Portland in a form substantially in accordance with the Intergovernmental Agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will deprive Multnomah County and the City of the mutual benefits of this agreement; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
