The Westside and Eastside Sewer Rehabilitation project involves the rehabilitation of combination sewers located on the Westside and the Eastside of Portland. Work shall include, but not be limited to:

- 1. Rehabilitate existing sewer with Cured-In-Place-Pipe (CIPP) liner.
- 2. Construct, maintain, and remove temporary work zone traffic control measures.
- 3. Construct, maintain, and remove erosion control measures.
- 4. Construct, maintain, and remove temporary flow diversion.
- 5. Construct drainage system including, sewer pipe, manholes, and inlets using open trench methods.
- 6. Construct trench pavement restoration.
- 7. Rehabilitate Manholes, install inside drops, minor adjustment of manholes, construct terminal & service lateral cleanouts.
- 8. Construct roadway improvements including, cold planning, aggregate base, HMAC wearing surfaces, concrete curb and sidewalks.
