ORDINANCE No. 185125

*Amend five contracts for the Career + College Connections (C3) Program to include services for the Summer 2012 session. (Ordinance; Contract No. 30002026, 30002028, 30002029, 30002031 and 30002032)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Summer Youth Connect is a four-year series of interventions (via Ninth Grade Counts, Career + College Connections, and SummerWorks programs) for targeted high school students during the summer months. Each year, students receive progressively more intensive academic support and career and college experiences as they move toward graduation and into higher education, training, and jobs. Using the research from Connected by 25, we can identify students with an elevated risk of dropping out of school and support them through key transitions to increase their likelihood of graduating
- 2. Career + College Connections (C3), sponsored by the Mayor's Office, acts as a bridge between the "career sampler" of Ninth Grade Counts and the internship of SummerWorks by providing career exploration and work readiness activities to help inform education and career planning.
- 3. The services were advertised under RFP 112610 and nine (9) responsive proposals were received. The selection committee reviewed and scored these proposals in accordance with PCC 5.68 and established contracts with the 5 highest scored proposers to provide the required services to the students.
- 4. The City desires to amend the following contracts in order to continue services through the 2012 summer program, as follows:
 - a. Amend Contract 30002026 with Impact Northwest, to add \$58,300 for a new not-to-exceed amount of \$184,750.
 - b. Amend Contract 30002028 with Immigrant & Refugee Community Organization, to add \$14,525 for a new not-to-exceed amount of \$56,525.
 - c. Amend Contract 30002029 with Latino Network, to add \$29,050 for a new not-to-exceed amount of \$77,050.
 - d. Amend Contract 30002031 with Self Enhancement, Inc (SEI), to add \$33,060 for a new not-to-exceed amount of \$64,920.
 - e. Amend Contract 30002032 with Reynolds School District, to add \$25,425 for a new not-to-exceed amount of \$53,675.
- 5. The M/W/ESB participation in this contract is zero.
- 6. Sufficient funding resides in Education Program Funds in the Mayor Office's Budget.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to amend the aforementioned contracts for continued services in accordance with their respective amendments attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to Impact Northwest chargeable to the Office of the Mayor when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to prevent disruption in the contractual services and avoid delay which would significantly affect the recruitment of these students. Therefore, this ordinance shall be full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
