ORDINANCE No. 185127

*Adopt a Waste Reduction Program and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro to receive Metro Waste Reduction Challenge Funds in the amount of \$265,909 and \$476,950 for the Recycle at Work Program in FY 11-12 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Metro has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant of Metro Waste Reduction Challenge Funds and the Recycle at Work Program in FY 11-12 to Bureau of Planning and Sustainability in the amount of \$265,909 and \$475,950.
- 2. Funds continue to support mutual regional and citywide goals for improved efforts in waste reduction and recycling volume.
- 3. The funding is appropriated in the FY 2011-12 Adopted Budget for the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from Metro for the Metro and Local Government Annual Waste Reduction Program and the Recycle at Work Program in the amount of \$265,909 and \$475,950 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in substantially the form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2011/2012 budget is hereby amended as follows: Total funds of \$734,000 were appropriated in the FY 11/12/ Adopted Budget, Ordinance #184679

<u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund 217 Business Area – PN00 Bureau Program Expenses– 00

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Metro for grant award number 930917, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that

increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
