Subject: Report on Education

Portland City Council has provided unprecedented financial support for education initiatives over the past three years. This report is intended to update you on the work funded by City Council to address the goals of increasing the graduation rate and doubling the post-secondary matriculation rates for Portland youth.

The Mayor's Education Team and community partners will share testimony on the impact of these and future investments. We see Education as a driver of equity and the economy and essential to a livable city.
