7. **BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:** Ordinance Number 183549 adopted on February 17, 2010 authorized a contract and provided payment for the construction of the 83<sup>rd</sup> Avenue Wastewater Pump Station (BES Project No. E08376) to convey flows from the construction of the Lents Sanitary Sewer Extension (BES Project No. E06954 – Ordinance No. 182878).
8. **FINANCIAL IMPACT:** The estimated project cost as designed was \$810,000.00 (high level of confidence). The bid by McClure and Sons Inc. is for the total of \$801,904.00. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services Project No. E08376.
9. **RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED:** Accept recommendation to award contract to McClure and Sons Inc. in the amount of \$801,904.00.
10. **SCOPE OF WORK ON PROJECT:** The project includes all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and supervision necessary to construct a new pump station and force main, 8-foot diameter wet well, sewage pumps and motors, vaults with connecting piping, generator with an automatic transfer system and shelter, pump station building with restroom and eco-roof, and frontage improvements.

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
