## ORDINANCE No. 185136

\*Authorize and accept Intergovernmental Grant Agreement of \$85,000 from Metro for the Green Development Resource Center (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Metro has awarded the City of Portland a grant for the Green Development Resource Center for FY 2011-12.
- 2. Since passage of Ordinance No. 181252 on September 5, 2007, Metro has contributed funding to the region-wide Green Development Resource Center to provide information about green building and site development practices to residents and the building industry throughout the Portland metro region.
- 3. The Green Development Resource Center represents a multi-jurisdictional resource that is housed at Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) and funded by regional governments to provide services beyond the Portland area that accelerate the spread of green building practices, waste reduction and site restoration activities. The Center leverages the City's efforts to make green building practices standard throughout the Portland region.
- 4. BPS staff in the City's Green Building and Development program continue to provide technical assistance, resources and training to the building industry and residents.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from Metro for the Green Development Resource Center in the amount of \$85,000 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in substantially the form of the attached exhibit A for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2011/2012 budget is hereby amended as follows: Total funds of \$85,000 were appropriated in the FY 11/12/ Adopted Budget, Ordinance #184679.

c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

d. The Director of Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Metro for grant award No. 930921 provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to accept funds to complete program objectives. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
