**Project Highlights:**

**History and project status**

- Outgrowth of the East Portland Action Plan
- Was funded by a Transportation and Growth Management grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation
- Project boundaries: I-205 to SE 174<sup>th</sup>
- Included oversight from:
  - Technical Advisory Group
  - Community Working Group
- Extensive community outreach: 5 open houses, neighborhood mtgs.

**Project Description**

- 3 lane cross-section from I-205 to SE 162<sup>nd</sup>
- 4 lane cross-section from SE 162<sup>nd</sup> to SE 174<sup>th</sup>
- Sidewalks and buffered bike lanes for the entire length of the project. 12 ft. sidewalk, 8 ft. buffered bike lane except where right-of-way may be constrained
- 104 Ft. right-of-way reservation which includes dedication and setbacks.

**Next Steps**

- Develop new street classifications based on plan
- Ensure setbacks are codified in the City Zoning Code
- Begin implementation of Master Street Plan for neighborhoods bordering Outer Powell
- Develop a prioritized project list to implement plan
