The impacts of the market, the requirements of colocating staff in one place, the pressure of staff layoffs and changes, and the requirements of setting up new processes, steps, and review bodies in Public Works permitting has been a very difficult task. I think the report you will be provided shows how far those efforts have taken us despite the many unforseen problems along the way.

Citywide Land Use Group has been involved in this process and been kept informed of the details of changes as they have gone forward.

As importantly, our role on the newly formed Appeals Panel has been useful for us and, I believe, for the panel as well.
