TO THE COUNCIL:

The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 113064 for The 80's Avenue Neighborhood Greenway for the Bureau of Transportation, with a project construction estimate of \$723,038.00. The Bureau of Transportation rated the level of project estimate confidence as Moderate.

Bids were opened on June 23, 2011, and four (4) bids were received. The low bid of Dirt & Aggregate Interchange, Inc. was deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation. It is recommended that the bid of Dirt & Aggregate Interchange, Inc. be accepted at the unit price quoted in their bid for a total estimated amount of \$563,848.00.

The Bureau of Transportation along with Procurement Services, identified thirteen (13) Divisions of Work as potential M/W/ESB subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$316,696.75 awarded to subcontractors.

M/W/ESB participation represents 52.8% or \$297,803.25 of the estimated contract amount:

- MBE (prime contractor) \$247,151.25 performing Clearing/Grubbing/Mowing/Brushing, Demolition, Excavating, Hauling Services (Trucking), Sewer/Water/Storm Drain, and Traffic Control Service (Includes TPDT)
- WBE (subcontractors) \$50,652.00 performing Asphalt Paving, Landscaping, and Traffic Signs

Dirt & Aggregate Interchange, Inc. has a current City of Portland Business License and their EEO Certification is current through January 18, 2013. The company is located in Fairview, Oregon, and is a State Certified M/W/ESB Contractor.

Dirt & Aggregate Interchange, Inc. is in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available for this project under Owner Cost Centers T00226 & 7TRES0000818.

It is further recommended that a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in the amount of 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor.

It is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.

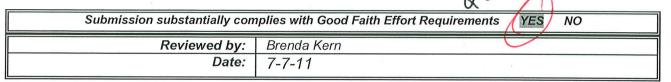

Clarifications: (Spoke to: Rene O'Rourke 7/11/11)

- 1. Form 2 Bud Bellamy & Sons is listed as an MWESB firm contacted for paving but I couldn't locate them on the OMWESB website. I have emailed OMWESB to determine whether they recently lost certification; however they contacted enough firms without counting Bud Bellamy & Sons, so no issue.
 - a. OMWESB sent an email back that Bud Bellamy lost their certification due to non-submission of documentation on 7/5/11; so no fault of the prime.
- 2. Form 2 Only 4 firms listed on the sheet for Striping firms solicited; however there are 2 other firms contacted but listed only under a different DOW, so no issue.
 - a. Rene stated that she listed 5 firms listed for her person to contact but they scratched Salem Striping out, she isn't sure why but will speak to them about it. She stated that none of the MWESB firms they contacted did striping. I notified OMWESB of this for their review.
