Subject: Appointments and re-appointments to the Plumbing Code Board of Appeal

This report is being submitted with clarification on the membership categories for the Plumbing Code Board of Appeal. There is a Public at Large position stated in Title 25.07.010. However, for clarification purposes we have submitted this report with the category being renamed to Plumbing Subject Matter Expert to more accurately reflect the qualification requirements of a third committee member.

In August 2010, the Plumbing Code Board of Appeal regular members were temporarily appointed and re-appointed by Mayor Sam Adams with terms expiring on December 31, 2010. The Plumbing Code Board of Appeal now has six vacancies – three regular members and three alternates.

**Re-appointments**

I am recommending the following re-appointments to the regular member positions: Steve Houston to the Plumbing Contractor position, Gary Toole to the Plumbing Design position, and Roy Moore to the Plumbing Subject Matter Expert position. The partial terms for these regular members will be from June 8, 2011 through December 31, 2013.

**Appointments**

I am also recommending the following appointments to vacant alternate member positions: Dale Lovett to the Plumbing Contractor Alternate position and Jonathan Gray to the Plumbing Design Alternate position. The 3-year terms for these alternate members will be from June 8, 2011 through June 7, 2014.

With these appointments, there is one lone vacancy in the alternate Plumbing Subject Matter Expert category. We will continue outreach efforts to fill that vacancy. I have enclosed an updated Plumbing Code Board of Appeal membership list for your records.

We will also revise section 25.07.010 Established -Terms-Vacancies in Portland City Code Title 25 (Plumbing Regulations) in the near future to clarify the membership categories. The board shall consist of a regular member and an alternate member in the following categories: plumbing contractor, plumbing design, and plumbing subject matter expert in plumbing installation and design.

***Plumbing Code Board of Appeals:***

The Plumbing Code Board of Appeal consists of three members appointed by the Mayor. One member shall be a plumbing contractor whose experience and training qualify him to decide matters concerning the safety of installations and devices regulated by PCC Title 25; one member shall be a person engaged in the design of plumbing installations whose experience and training qualify him to decide matters concerning the safety of installations and devices and one member who shall be a member of the public at large. Code Board of Appeals hears appeals of plumbing code issues which are appealed beyond the Administrative Appeals Board. The Appeals Board may affirm annul or modify the action of BDS on the condition that substantially equivalent safety is provided generally conforming to national standards concerning fire prevention, fire safety measures, and building construction requirements for safety.


