7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services supplies the fuel used by the City of Portland vehicles. In 2009 the State of Oregon issued a competitive solicitation on behalf of state agencies for universal fleet credit card services specifically for the purchase of fuels, alternate fuels and other petroleum products. The State of Oregon Price Agreement #8871 to U. S. Bank National Association ND by and on behalf of its wholly owned subsidiary, Voyager Fleet Systems, Inc. was initiated in September 2009. On June 28, 2010 the City entered into a participating agreement to procure the City's fuel via the fleet credit card.

Due to increased usage and the rising fuel costs, the City's current agreement needs to be amended to provide for the necessary fuel needs of the City. Presently, the State of Oregon cooperative contract with Voyager is valid through June 2015. CityFleet is requesting an increase to cover the costs of external fuel services for city vehicles and there is a need to amend this contract so it can be used for the remainder of the city's cooperative state contract.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated value of the fuel amendment is \$4,676,000 for FY 2012-2015. This is funded by Interagency charges within CityFleet's operating budget.

9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

Amend contract with U. S. Bank National Association ND, Voyager Fleet Systems Inc for the City's fuel needs.
