The Portland Police Bureau will receive funding from Trimet for the purchase of one SUV for the K9 drug sniffing unit. The purchase price is estimated at \$40,000 and Trimet will reimburse the City for this expense. Annual repair and maintenance expenses are estimated to be \$2,970 and annual fuel costs totaling \$2,700. Charges for fuel and repair services occur in accordance with the interagency agreement between CityFleet and the Portland Police Bureau.
