1. **Page 5, four Portland Plan priorities** (Prosperity, Education, Health, Equity):  
Omits “environment”, change to “Health and Environment”?
2. **Page 7, equity** (add “age” to description of Portland’s increasing diversity):  
“Portland is becoming a more racially ~~and~~ ethnically, and age diverse city with more newcomers.”
3. **Page 16 – add:** “Portland has been named on at least two national lists as one of the best places to retire.”
4. **Page 17 – add:** New statement about budget challenges for public transportation.
5. **\*Page 87, Action 75:** Replace “elderly and disabled people” with the terms “elders and people with disabilities”.
