ORDINANCE No. 185183

* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$13,168 from the Oregon Department of Education to implement child wellness practices in afterschool programs (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) applied to the Oregon Department of Education for a grant in the amount of \$12,268 for implementing child wellness practices in afterschool programs on November 30, 2011.
- 2. The Oregon Department of Education has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the implementation of child wellness practices in afterschool programs to Portland Parks & Recreation in the amount of \$13,168.
- 3. Grant funding will be used to develop and implement curriculum related to nutrition, cooking, gardening, and active play at St. Johns and University Park Community Centers, as well as for education and outreach activities to other Portland Parks & Recreation sites, childcare providers, and the community.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Education for implementing child wellness practices in afterschool programs in the amount of \$13,168.
- b. The FY 2011/2012 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217

Business Area – PK00

Bureau Program Expenses-\$6,968

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of Portland Parks & Recreation of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Oregon Department of Education for the Afterschool Child Wellness Practices grant, award number 26 16026, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
