AMENDMENT OF IGA AND INTERIM MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

Portland Parks & Recreation (Parks) and the Portland Development Commission (PDC) entered into an IGA approved under Ordinance 182361 and executed on December 11, 2008. The Ordinance identified the need for a neighborhood park in the Gateway Regional Center Urban Renewal Area (Gateway URA).

The IGA specified that Parks and PDC would enter into an interim management agreement, and that agreement went into effect March 9, 2009. Parks and PDC have split interim management costs per the interim management agreement.

The IGA and interim management agreement have expired and need to be extended to allow ongoing management including payment of 2011 costs totaling \$2,095.87 and payment of future management expenses.

Agreed:

1. The term of the IGA is extended until June 30, 2013.

- 2. The term of the Interim Management Agreement is extended to June 30, 2013.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the IGA and the Interim Management Agreement remain in effect.
