

ORDINANCE No. **185194**

*Extend Intergovernmental Agreement between the Multnomah County District Attorney Office for community outreach for youth violence prevention (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30001038)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance awarded the Multnomah County District Attorney's Office (MCDAO) \$139,687 in grant funds from the FY09 Oregon Project Safe Neighborhood Program on August 26, 2009;
2. Multnomah County notified the City of Portland, as sub-grantee, and the Police Bureau Gang Enforcement Team (GET) that they would receive \$4,944.85;
3. GET utilized these funds to create volunteer foot patrols of areas with frequent gang activity, including sweatshirts to identify and protect volunteers and to cover overtime staffing for historically violent events;
4. Authorization of Intergovernmental Agreement (MC #4600007987) between the City and Multnomah County stipulates the County will reimburse the City, as sub-grantee, for approved program expenses not to exceed \$4,944.85 and is conditioned upon both parties' agreement to the attached IGA; and
5. The original grant period starting October 1, 2009, will to be extended in order to meet a continuing need through March 31, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to extend, on behalf of the City of Portland, a grant from Multnomah County for community outreach for youth violence prevention in the amount of 4,995.85.
- b. The Mayor and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to authorize this Intergovernmental Agreement substantially in accordance with the Agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
