

## **ORDINANCE No. 185202**

- \* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$64,000 from Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for the implementation of state and local homeland security strategies. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

### Section 1. The Council finds

1. On August 17, 2011 the City of Portland passed Ordinance 184814, authorizing the Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) to apply to the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for a grant from the State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP).
2. The Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management has notified the City of Portland that it will award an SHSGP FY 2011 grant to Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) in the amount of \$64,000 for support of the Interoperable Communications project.
3. No match is required by this grant.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland an SHSGP FY 2011 grant from the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for support of the Interoperable Communications project in the amount of \$64,000.
- b. The FY 2011/2012 budget is hereby amended as follows:
  - GRANTS FUND
  - Fund 217
  - Business Area – FR00
  - Bureau Program Expenses – \$64,000
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Fire Chief of PF&R is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for the SHSGP FY 2011 grant, award number 11-276, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.




