ORDINANCE No. 185219

* Accept funds from Grant High School students for the construction of a community garden. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In order to achieve the 1000 plot goal set forth in the Community Gardens Initiative, Portland Parks and Recreation (PPR) has developed a partnership with Portland Public Schools (PPS) and the students at Grant High School to build a new community garden. The new garden will be operated by PPR through the Community Gardens Program. The garden will be located on PPS property and added as an addendum to an existing Joint Use IGA.
- 2. In order to pay for the costs to construct the garden, Grant High students have received a \$50,000 grant from State Farm Insurance. This money is being held in an account by PPS.
- 3. To ensure construction meets PPR standards, PPR crews will perform construction services for this project.
- Construction must be completed prior to the end of the school year June 13, 2012 so 4. the students who have helped build the garden can participate prior to graduation.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- PPR Director Mike Abbaté shall accept funds from PPS on behalf of the Grant a. High School students and apply the funds to the construction of the Grant Community Garden.
- b. O&M is expected to be \$1600 per year. Parks shall request the funds in the 2013/14 Fall BPM.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid further delay in the construction of the community garden prior to the growing season; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
