

ORDINANCE No. 185223

Authorize a contract with ClarusTec, Inc. for a .NET Technical Consultant for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$149,400 for replatforming of the Fire Information System (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland's (City) Public Safety Systems Revitalization Program (PSSRP) was established to manage and coordinate the replacement and upgrade of the City's Public Safety Systems including upgrading of the City's Fire Information System.
2. The mission of the Public Safety Revitalization Project is to implement the revitalization of critical public safety information systems that will meet the City's needs. As such, the City of Portland public safety agencies are dependent on technology for a variety of communications, operations, and records functions.
3. The City requires expert assistance with technical and instructive services to assist the City's applications team's process of learning .NET skills and applying them to replatforming of the Fire Information System.
4. The services were competitively solicited under Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 113989 and eight responsive proposals were received. The selection committee reviewed and scored these proposals in accordance with PCC 5.68 and determined that ClarusTec, Inc. was the highest scored proposer.
5. The City desires to enter into a Professional, Technical and Expert (PTE) contract with ClarusTec, Inc., with a not-to-exceed contract amount of \$149,400.00 for a period of 2 years to provide training and technical quality management.
6. ClarusTec, Inc is EEO certified but is not a certified State of Oregon Minority-owned business. There is no M/W/ESB participation in this contract.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to enter into a contract with ClarusTec, Inc., for services in a form substantially in conformance with the contract attached hereto as Exhibit A, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants payable to the contractor when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.


