7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

This ordinance authorizes an amendment, Exhibit A attached, to the contract to extend the expiration date of the contract through March 31, 2013. City of Portland Code 5.33.220.D.10 authorizes the renegotiation of existing contracts with incumbent contractors when it is in the best interests of the City. The Contractor was competitively awarded their current price agreement in September 2005 after receiving the highest evaluated points. They have performed well under this price agreement and have consistently offered excellent pricing and service.

The City of Portland provides safe and secure facilities for its employees and visitors. To continue doing so the City has the need for high level professional unarmed and armed security within its many Bureaus, facilities and locations. GS4 has exceeded the City's requirements by successfully providing consistent coverage with the highest degree of professionalism throughout the many variable conditions and locations surrounding the need to have security services present. The established internal procedures within GS4 coordinated with the City Bureaus and Offices for the enforcement of the Building Rules of Conduct; along with their ability to provide set location and rolling security escorts, armed Security services and the positive relationships formed with both the public and the City Staff makes change during these difficult economic times an unnecessary risk. Continuity of Security services and personnel is imperative to a successful effective Security Program.

For this contract GS4 employs 42 FTE, exceeds the City fair wage requirements for all employees, has 33% participation with the employer offered Kaiser health plan, offers health benefits to all fulltime employees after 90 days employment and for this Portland Office employs 18.11% Women and 13.93% Minority. GS4 employs 13 FTE's from DePaul Industries (QRF) and continues to provide partnership opportunities with the DePaul Industries by providing 173 hours per month of on site training for people with disabilities.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

This amendment for uniformed security officer services will increase the contract amount by \$131,837.81 per month (6,279.3 monthly hours) for one (1) year for a total annual cost of \$1,582,053.74. An additional amount is being added to the Contract value for Parks services through March 31, 2012, in the amount of \$34,765.00, making the total additional Contract value \$1,616,818.74. This will bring the new Contract total value to \$10,156,122.10.

The total annual cost of this amendment, with the exception of services provided to Parks and Recreation, is included in the Facilities budget for fiscal years 2011-12 through 2012-13. The cost of the security services provided under this contract are charged to the Bureaus directly or recovered through the location rental rates. Parks and Recreation is invoiced directly by the vendor for services provided under this contract.
