## ORDINANCE No. 185226

\*Authorize application to the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for additional funds from the FY2011 State Homeland Security Grant Program in the amount of \$150,000 for the implementation of state and local homeland security strategies. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council Finds:

- 1. During the summer of 2011 the State facilitated a county allocation application for local and tribal jurisdictions throughout the State for the FY2011 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP). The Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) applied for funds which were accepted by Council on February 15, 2012 via ordinance 185142.
- 2. All projects received by the State were evaluated and funded according to the aforementioned application process. However, due to project delays or savings, additional funds are available for local and tribal jurisdictions to competitively request to facilitate projects in support of the state's FY2011 investment justifications, and State Homeland Security Strategy.
- 3. PBEM, through Multnomah County Emergency Management, will apply to the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management for an SHSGP FY 2011 Part 2 grant in the amount of \$150,000 in order to facilitate the development of a countywide disaster debris management plan in alignment with the outcomes of previous regional efforts. These funds will be an addition to the current SHSGP FY2011 grant.
- 4. City Code requires that grant applications be approved by ordinance prior to submission. Because no ordinance has approved the application, the Office of Emergency Management is submitting to Council for approval by ordinance.
- 5. No match is required by this Grant

## NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- a. The Mayor and Portland Bureau of Emergency Management are authorized to apply for the grant from the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management in the amount of \$150,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
