

ORDINANCE No. **185228**

*Authorize a grant agreement with the Rosewood Initiative for \$8,850 to develop a community meeting space (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Rosewood Initiative plays a critical role in building a stronger community network in a high-risk neighborhood by implementing community involvement strategies.
2. In an effort to grow its mission, the organization will open a central meeting space to act as both a police contact office and community center. The Rosewood Initiative has received contributions for renovation and further development from Multnomah County.
3. Because the community center will meet crucial policing goals for the neighborhood, the City of Portland Police Bureau will grant the organization \$8,850 in order to complete the community room construction.
4. The grant will be used to pay for permitting fees, equipment, and other materials necessary to complete the community meeting space.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a grant to the Rosewood Initiative in a form substantially in agreement with the agreement attached as exhibit A, in the amount of \$8,850.
- b. The Mayor and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay the grantee from existing Police Bureau General Fund appropriations.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the Rosewood Initiative's ability to complete the community meeting and police contact center. Therefore, the ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
