ORDINANCE No. 185231

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation to allow the Bureau of Transportation access to traffic data provided by INRIX, Incorporated (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Increasing traffic congestion is occurring throughout the City of Portland and should be measured to address the significant impact on citizens' quality of life and the economic growth of the region.
- 2. ODOT and the Bureau of Transportation have and will continue to work together on improvements to the City's transportation system that benefit both citizens and businesses; the sharing of this data will provide the City and its engineers with traffic speed information that will help identify periods of congestion.
- 3. ODOT has a license agreement with INRIX, a privately held traffic services company, to provide them with traffic data for approximately 10,000 miles of Oregon roads, including over 4,000 in the Portland area. INRIX utilizes the nation's largest GPS probe vehicle fleet and other data sources to generate travel time data.
- 4. ODOT will allow PBOT to access this INRIX data at no cost to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Director of the Bureau of Transportation is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with ODOT, substantially in accordance with the agreement attached to the original of this Ordinance and, by reference, made a part hereof.
