ORDINANCE NO. 185254

* Authorize application to Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board for a grant up to \$200,000 for River View Natural Area Habitat Restoration Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Water quality and watershed management is a key concern for the Portland region in general and for the Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) in particular.
- 2. In 2007, the City launched the Grey to Green Initiative (G2G), aimed at accelerating the implementation of the Portland Watershed Management Plan. G2G focuses on seven key components. Most pertinent to this proposal is the goal to control invasive species on 800 acres.
- 3. The City of Portland, BES and Portland Parks and Recreation (PP&R), recently purchased 146 acres of the River View Cemetery, a high-priority natural area in the Willamette Watershed. Restoration of this natural area will help BES to meet its G2G goals.
- 4. The Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board (OWEB) offers grant funding for restoration and enhancement. BES has prepared a grant application to submit to OWEB requesting grant funds for restoration of this recently-acquired property.
- 5. The grant from OWEB requires a minimum 25% match. A minimum local match in the amount of \$50,000 will be provided by funds from the FY 2012/13 proposed budgets of BES and PP&R in the form of salary, benefits and services. Matching funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2012/13 proposed budget of BES (E10190) and PP&R's Sellwood Bridge (4f) mitigation funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make an application to OWEB for a grant in the amount of \$200,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The Office of Management and Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists since the application must be delivered by April 16, 2012. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
