- 7. **BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:** Ordinance Number 185129 adopted on February 1, 2012 authorized a contract and provided for payment for the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant Secondary Process Improvements Project. The purpose of this project is to improve the secondary treatment system at the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant (CBWTP). Improvements are needed to update and automate the monitoring and control systems to handle rapid flow changes from the recently completed East Side Combined Sewer Overflow program.
