The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City requires the services of outside legal counsel due to workload considerations and a conflict of interest in employee grievance matters related to Campbell v City of Portland et al.
- 2. The law firm of Littler Mendelson PC agreed to provide these services by contract no. 30001850.
- 3. Due to the nature and complexity of the matter it is necessary to amend the the agreement as required to increase the amount of the contract and/or extend the terms of the agreement, in a form closely resembling the attached draft amendment

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The City Attorney is authorized to enter into and amend, with the a. approval of the Portland Police Bureau, the outside legal service agreement with Littler Mendelson PC for grievances filed in relation to the matter of Campbell v City of Portland et al.
- If applicable, the provisions of City Code Chapter 5.68 are waived. b.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are authorized to draw and deliver warrants in payment of legal services provided under this ordinance.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to continue to pay for legal services in a timely manner for the grievance matters related to Campbell v City et al; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.




