## **ORDINANCE** No.

Allow consumption of alcohol in the Public Right of Way provided a permit to authorize a Community Event Street Closure is issued under Chapter 17.44. (Ordinance; amend Code Section 14A.50.010)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Chapter 17.44 authorizes the City Engineer to grant permits to close a street for special events, such as block parties or neighborhood fairs under certain conditions.
- 2. The Bureau of Transportation issues 175 to 200 permits annually and 25% involve alcohol in the street area.
- 3. The Bureau of Transportation submits an ordinance with conditions for each community event street closure permit that has alcohol in the street. The ordinance for the event waives 14A.50.010 for the dates, times and location of the street closure permit. 14A.50.010 states that it is unlawful for any person to drink alcohol upon any street, sidewalk, or other public right of way except as provided in 14A.50.010C that states: *this section does not apply to prohibit the consumption of alcoholic liquor in sidewalk cafes which have been issued permits under Chapter 17.25 of this code.*
- 4. The Bureau of Transportation proposes to add similar language to PCC 14A.50.010 C to recognize street closures for community event permitted areas the same as sidewalk cafe permitted areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Amend Chapter 14 Public Order and Police to allow consumption of alcohol in the public right of way provided a permit authorizing a Community Event Street Closure has been issued under Chapter 17.44.010, as set forth in this Ordinance.
- Add Subsection 14A.50.010 D. as follows: This section does not prohibit the use of alcohol in the street area where a community event street closure permit has been issued by the Bureau of Transportation under PCC Chapter 17.44 if the Permittee has obtained all necessary permits and has complied with all applicable Oregon Liquor Control Commission requirements.
