- 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS: Ordinance Number 183325 adopted November 12, 2009 authorized a contract and provided for payment for the construction of the South Auditorium Lighting, Phase I, American Recovery and Reinvestment Act project.
- 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT: The estimated project cost was \$4,941,528.90. Per the bid submission, the total amount is \$4,382,700.50. Funds for this project are available in the Bureau of Transportation FY 2010-11 Budget under WBS T009.C19, and are federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds administered by the Oregon Department of Transportation.
