Subject: Accept the Education Strategies Report

The Education Strategies Report highlights the work of the Education Cabinet, and the transition of that work to a greater Cradle to Career strategy. The Report provides an overview of the four primary strategies that represent the bulk of the Education Cabinet's work over the last two years. The first of these strategies is SUMMER YOUTH CONNECT, which is geared towards helping youth connect during the summer time to jobs, internships and career and college exposure opportunities. The second is FUTURE CONNECT, intended to help youth access and graduate from community college through financial aid days, scholarship dollars, and paid advisors. The third strategy is COMMUNITY CONNECT, which helps to build more supportive and caring relationships with young people through support from families, community volunteers and educators. The last is OPPORTUNITY CONNECT, which focuses on the most effective ways of investing in high school youth through existing systems such as SUN, enhancing the opportunities and social service/health supports necessary to make them successful graduates.

The Report also reviews the transition from the Education Cabinet to the Cradle to Career Council, how that transition came about and the value-add of this shift.

In addition to the report, four presenters will elaborate on this work and the future direction of this organization. These presenters are Carole Smith, Superintendent of Portland Public Schools; Bill Scott, former chair of The Leader's roundtable; Dan Ryan CEO of Portland Schools Foundation, and Sarah Menseh COO of The Portland Trailblazers.
