The security services costs will be approximately \$535,800 in FY11/12, an increase of \$75,000. Beginning in FY12/13, annual costs will be approximately \$635,800, an increase of \$175,000. Funds for the additional expenses will come from the Parking Facilities Fund (606000). The level of confidence is <u>high</u> that expenses will come in on target, due to the increased level of security requested and the additional costs estimated by Portland Patrol, Inc.
