7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

This ordinance will settle an employment discrimination lawsuit filed by a Parks and Recreation employee against the City and her former crew leader and supervisor. The lawsuit was brought after Ms. Lauer complained in 2008 about sexually inappropriate conduct by her crew leader that occurred in 2004 or 2006. She alleges that she was sexually harassed and then retaliated against once she reported the harassment. The City investigated the harassment complaint and took appropriate corrective action, and denies retaliating against Ms. Lauer. But given that violations of Rule 2.02 were substantiated, settling the case for \$25,000 inclusive of attorney's fees before engaging in extensive litigation is recommended by City Risk and the City Attorney's office.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

Approval of the settlement would result in a payment of \$12,500 from the liability fund and \$12,500 from the Parks and Recreation payroll account minus required withholding.

9. RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED

Approve settlement of Stacey Lauer bodily injury lawsuit in the sum of \$25,000.
