TO THE COUNCIL:

The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 111764 for the Road Rehabilitation - 2010 SE Clinton Street Project for the Portland Bureau of Transportation, with a project construction estimate of \$844,535.91. The Portland Bureau of Transportation rated the level of project estimate confidence as Optimal.

Bids were opened on May 18, 2010, and eight (8) bids were received. The low bid of Kodiak Pacific Construction was deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation and it is recommended that their bid be accepted at the unit price quoted in their bid for a total estimated amount of \$697,697.00.

The Portland Bureau of Transportation and Procurement Services identified eight (8) Divisions of Work as potential M/W/ESB subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$302,047.00 being awarded to subcontractors.

The Divisions of Work identified were:

Asphalt Paving	Hauling Services (Trucking)
Concrete Cutting	Sewer, Water & Storm Drain Work
Concrete Work	Striping
Excavating	Traffic Control Services (Includes TPDT)

In their bid Kodiak Pacific Construction, a certified WBE, indicated their intent to self-perform the following divisions of work:

Excavation	Sewer, Water & Storm Drain Work

Including the Prime Contractor, MWESB participation represents 64.1% or \$447,600.00 of the estimated total project cost of \$697,697.00.

- WBE \$395,650.00 (Prime) performing Asphalt Paving, Excavation, Sewer, Water & Storm Drain Work.

It is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
