## Letter of Agreement

This Agreement is entered into between City of Portland ("City") and The District Council of Trade Unions ("DCTU").

## Background

- The City and the District Council of Trades Unions (DCTU) are parties to a collective bargaining agreement effective July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2013.
- 2. The City requires employees working in certain classifications to possess a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL) if they perform or have any expectation of performing safety-sensitive duties as defined by the US Department of Transportation Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration regulations. Some employees may be assigned to classifications in which not all positions require a CDL.
- 3. The City plans to cut a number of positions and lay off DCTU represented employees.
- 4. Currently the City and the DCTU do not have an agreement that would allow employees who do not hold a valid CDL and who bump to a position that requires it time to obtain a valid CDL in order to be qualified to perform the duties associated with the classification.
- The parties agree that it is in their mutual best interest to allow such employees a grace period to obtain a CDL.

## Agreement

The parties agree as follows:

- An employee who does not hold a valid CDL at the time he or she bumps to a position that requires a CDL shall have up to sixty (60) days from the date the he or she moves to the new position to obtain a valid CDL.
- An employee without a valid CDL who bumps to a position that requires a valid CDL shall be accommodated for up to sixty (60) days in a non-CDL assignment until he or she obtains a valid CDL.
- 3. If an employee is unable to obtain a valid CDL within the sixty (60) day period, he or she shall be laid off according to the provisions of Article 14.
- 4. The parties agree that the terms of this Agreement shall not establish any precedent whatsoever.
- 5. This agreement sunsets on June 30, 2013.
- 6. This Letter of Agreement shall become effective upon ratification by City Council.
