

**RESOLUTION No. 36923**

Approve renaming of Brunish Hall to Brunish Theatre in the New Theatre Building of the Portland Center for the Performing Arts (Resolution)

**WHEREAS**, the City of Portland is owner of the facilities comprising the Portland Center for the Performing Arts (PCPA) and has contracted with Metro for their management and operation together with other regional facilities through the Metropolitan Exposition-Recreation Commission (MERC); and

**WHEREAS**, the MERC acted by Resolution on March 13, 1992 to approve a Policy for Naming Buildings, Theatres and Spaces at the Portland Center for the Performing Arts which includes a schedule of gifts appropriate for the number of locations in the three PCPA buildings including the unfinished fourth floor space of the New Theatre Building; and

**WHEREAS**, the MERC acted by Resolution on January 20, 1999 to accept a proposal for a gift of \$350,000 from an anonymous donor for the permanent naming of the fourth floor space in the New Theatre Building; and

**WHEREAS**, the design and construction of a multi-purpose arts space was funded through the resources of two naming gifts and was completed for dedication and opening on February 11, 2000 when the name of the donor was revealed; and

**WHEREAS**, through Resolution #35874 on April 5, 2000, City Council approved the naming of Brunish Hall in the New Theatre Building of the Portland Center for the Performing Arts; and

**WHEREAS**, the same donor has recently made an additional contribution to PCPA to greatly improve the amenities in Brunish Hall in order to be a better fit for theatrical productions;

**WHEREAS**, the same donor has agreed to cover any expenses associated with the signage and name change;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Portland approves the permanent re-naming of Brunish Hall to Brunish Theatre to help elevate its reputation as a performance space, and commends the donor for his generosity in this gift to the community and to the well-being of its performing arts facilities.
