TO THE COUNCIL:

The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 111188 for the Portland Bicycle Boulevard Improvements for the Bureau of Transportation, with a project construction estimate of \$ 712,019.00. The Bureau of Transportation rated the level of project estimate confidence as Optimal.

Because <u>Striping & Signing</u> is not generally a prime contractor area of work only three contractors attended the mandatory prebid meeting. Bids were opened on January 26, 2010, and two (2) bids were received. The low bid of Brown Contracting, Inc. was deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation. It is recommended that the bid of Brown Contracting, Inc. be accepted at the unit price quoted in their bid for a total estimated amount of \$626,151.00.

On September 7, 2005, Council approved Ordinance #179568, which authorizes an intergovernmental agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) to authorize the City to participate in the Local Public Agency Certification Program. ODOT's Local Agency Certification (LAC) program allows ODOT to delegate authority to the City to administer City Federal-Aid Transportation projects and under that program to become a certified local agency. This project is one of the test projects that will be reviewed and audited by ODOT for compliance with the City-ODOT requirements.

Part of the agreement is that the State shall administer on behalf of the City the project's Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) program, Equal Employment Opportunity (EEO) program, and the On-The-Job Training (OJT) program.

ODOT establishes the minimum DBE goal for each Federal-Aid project. The criteria used in assigning project goals includes, project location, size, duration, dollar value and the availability of DBE firms that perform identified subcontracting opportunities. Based on the narrow scope of this project that involves the installation of pavement markings and signage, the State established a 0% DBE goal. In their bid Brown Contracting, Inc. indicated their intent to self-perform all work.

Brown Contracting, Inc. has a current City of Portland Business License and their EEO Certification is current through April 30, 2010. The company is located in Eugene, Oregon, and is not a State Certified M/W/ESB Contractor.

Brown Contracting, Inc. is in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

The Bureau of Transportation is using federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 funds administered by ODOT; therefore, ARRA requirements apply to this project. Funds are available for this project under Owner Cost Center T00188.C42.

It is further recommended that a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond each in the amount of 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor.

It is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
