7. BACKGR	OUND/ANALYSIS: Ordinance Number 183327 adopted on November

- 12, 2009, authorized a contract and provided payment for the construction of the Portland Bicycle Boulevard Improvements project.
- 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT: The estimated project cost was \$1,000,000.00. Per the bid submission, the total amount is \$626,151.00. Funds for this project are available in the Bureau of Transportation FY 2009-10 Budget under Owner Cost Center T00188.C42. Work under this contract will be funded in part with federal funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) administered by the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT).
- **9.** RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED: Accept Recommendation to award contract to Brown Contracting, Inc in the amount of \$ 626,151.00.
- 10. <u>SCOPE OF WORK ON PROJECT:</u> The project includes all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and supervision necessary to complete the installation of pavement markings and signage along 53 miles of City of Portland designated Bike Boulevards as shown in the project plan set. Improvements shall consist of

constructing, maintaining, and removing temporary work zone traffic control measures; placing pavement markings and striping; installing signing; and performing additional and incidental work as called for by the specifications and plans.
