ORDINANCE No. 185323

* Amend grant agreement with Catholic Charities' Proyecto UNICA to provide navigator/ advocacy services and to administer client assistance funds for all participants at the Gateway Center for Domestic Violence Services. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32000391)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- On October 21, 2009, the City Council, through Portland City Ordinance no. 183257, entered into an intergovernmental agreement with Multnomah County, Oregon (County) to jointly operate a One Stop Center for Domestic Violence (County Contract no.30000956). The Center is now known as the Gateway Center for Domestic Violence Services ("the Center").
- 2. A request for proposals for grant funding to provide "navigator" (advocacy) services and administration of client assistance funds was circulated amongst community-based domestic violence service providers on April 15, 2010.
- 3. Catholic Charities' Proyecto UNICA, a non-profit corporation, sought grant funding to provide the navigator services and agreed to take a leadership and administrative role with client assistance funds intended for use generally by participants at the Center.
- 4. Portland City Council, through City Ordinance No. 183785, authorized a grant agreement with Grantee after Grantee was selected for grant award based on its response to the request for proposals.
- 5. The resulting Grant Agreement No. 32000391 was executed on or about June 1, 2010. The effective date of the Grant Agreement was June 1, 2010 to May 31, 2013.
- 6. The Gateway Center seeks to extend the term of the Grant Agreement No. 32000391 such that Catholic Charities' Proyecto UNICA can administer an additional \$40,000 in client assistance funds.
- 7. The Center has operational funds to extend the payment for navigator services provided by Catholic Charities until June 30, 2014. In order to increase the term by one year and one month the grant will be increased by \$60,666.67.
- 8. The new term extends client assistance administration and funds until June 30, 2015 and navigator services funds until June 30, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to sign the grant amendment with Catholic Charities in substantial conformance with the one attached as Exhibit A and approved as to form by the City Attorney.
- b. The grant funding for the additional client assistance funds will be from the Center's ongoing operations budget. \$38,000 will be dispersed to assist client and \$2000 will be an administrative fee.
- c. The grant funding for the additional navigator services will be from the Center's ongoing operations budget. \$60,666.67 will be dispersed to fund services through June 30, 2014.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the contract; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
