*Authorize Memorandum of Understanding with the American Red Cross for shelter trailer ownership and management (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Red Cross is a community-based organization that mobilizes people to aid victims of emergencies with the aim of preventing and relieving suffering. The Red Cross is closely integrated into community response efforts, including the efforts of federal, state and local government and non-governmental organizations. The Red Cross works with all partners to lead a well-integrated, effective and efficient response to every emergency.
2. Per the Memorandum of Understanding, the City of Portland (City) will transfer ownership and management of an enclosed trailer and its contents of sheltering supplies to the Red Cross. The trailer and its contents were purchased with Urban Areas Security Initiative grant funds.
3. The City recognizes the benefit to its citizens of having this agreement in place.
4. There are no charges involved for the City, or its citizens, for the services provided by the Chapter.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the American Red Cross, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the attached Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because there is no way to predetermine when a disaster may strike, or when the citizens of the City of Portland need to have these services available; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


