ORDINANCE NO. 185345

*Authorize the Portland Water Bureau to acquire a conservation easement and an access and utility easement on property owned by Catholic Youth Organization/Camp Howard (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In 2008, the Catholic Youth Organization/Camp Howard (CYO) announced plans to harvest an 80-acre parcel of its land located directly adjacent to the Bull Run Watershed Closure Area and zoned as Timber District in Clackamas County.
- 2. CYO's property is steep-sloped and harvesting timber will increase the likelihood of a landslide event. A landslide event at this location would jeopardize PWB roads, conduits, and the Lower Bull Run River where PWB is investing significant resources to protect fish in compliance with the Federal Endangered Species and Clean Water Acts.
- 3. PWB appraised the market value of the CYO property and timber, and has negotiated an agreement of terms and conditions related to a 50-year conservation easement to prevent harvest of timber on the highest-risk portion of the CYO property (34.02 acres). The agreement also includes a perpetual easement for a segment of the primary access road in the watershed (Waterworks Road), which presently crosses CYO property.
- 4. The cost for the easements on CYO property is \$149,083. Funds for this acquisition are available in the Bull Run Watershed sub-program in the FY 2011-12 budget and will not result in a change in the forecast water rates.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Chief Engineer of the Portland Water Bureau is authorized to execute on behalf of the City the acceptance of a conservation easement and an access and utility easement from CYO substantially in accordance with the agreements attached as Attachment A and Attachment B to this Ordinance.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the funding allocated for this project expires on June 30, 2012 and any delay in conveyance of these easements could jeopardize the acquisition. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
