The procurement action was approved via Ordinance No. 183467 based on an engineer's estimate of \$1,400,000 with an Optimal Confidence Rating. The original contract amount was \$501,125; Change Orders 1 through 5 added \$30,768.72 to the contract, and the final contract cost is \$531,893.72. The actual cost is 6.1% over the original contract amount for the project. All work on the contract was completed satisfactorily on January 18, 2012. The Final Payment to be made in the amount of \$26,594.69 is for release of all retainage.
