ORDINANCE No. 185354

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$2,500,000 from Oregon Department of Transportation and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement for grading, drainage, paving, signing, signals, and roadside development as part of the Division Street Reconstruction Project: SE 6th – César Chávez Blvd / SE 39th Ave (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) applied to Metro for a grant in the amount of \$2,500,000 for the Division Street Reconstruction Project in 2005.
- 2. Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Division Street Reconstruction Project: SE 6th César Chávez Boulevard to PBOT in the amount of \$2,500,000.
- 3. The project implements the recommendations of the Division Street Reconstruction Project Streetscape Plan adopted by City Council in June 2010 (Resolution No. 36797).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Division Street Reconstruction Project in the amount of \$2,500,000 and execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in substantially the form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.
 - The Division Street Reconstruction Project (T00006) and Grant (TR000134) are budgeted in the FY 11/12 budget and the balance of the grant award will be included in the FY 12/13 budget.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
